Migrating from a traditional to a post-industrial society has brought significant changes to the way we work. In the middle-class and upper-middle-class society, new working forms have been adopted, psychological and financial pressures increased, and the concept of decent work and fair job-related and organisational aspects of work at different stages of life have been questioned. In the empirical part of the paper we therefore focus on working time, work organisation and co-operation with teams, work-life balance, health and stress, and overall satisfaction with working conditions. Our results evidence that new working forms increase insecurity and consequently diminish workers' well-being, and this is most experienced by younger, agency and self-employed workers at present. This suggests that the development of multi-level and multifaceted measures which take into account socio-psychological and legislative factors to combat within market segmentation is necessary, especially when addressing the needs of those forced to work atypical.
