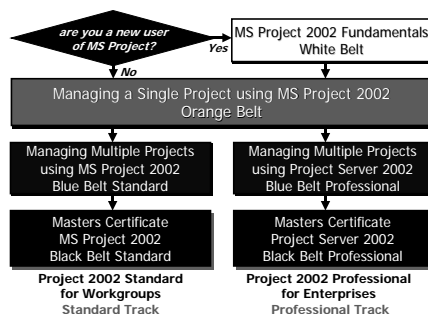


## The Project 2002 Certification Curriculum

### Three Levels of Certification

The curriculum consists of four levels. Each level is designed with a specific target group in mind (see the illustration below):<sup>3</sup>

- ◆ Microsoft Project 2002 Fundamentals (*White Belt*) for people who are new to MS Project
- ◆ Managing a Single Project with MS Project (*Orange Belt*) for project managers who use MS Project regularly
- ◆ Managing Multiple Projects with MS Project (*Blue Belt Standard*) or with Project Server (*Blue Belt Professional*) for project managers who manage multiple projects
- ◆ Masters Certificate in MS Project (*Black Belt Standard*) or Project Server (*Black Belt Professional*) for project office staff



In the Orange Belt workshop we bring people who make nice charts of their projects to the level of making dynamic *models* of their projects that produce valid forecasts. If a person is certified at the Orange Belt level, we guarantee their employer that the person has a demonstrated capability to create good schedules of their own projects. The Orange Belt is tailored to project managers and schedulers.

This book will cover all of the content presented in the Orange Belt level workshop as offered by IIL.

The Blue Belt is designed for people who manage multiple projects simultaneously. These people have successfully managed single projects and have ended up managing
