Abstract

Monograph represents a pioneering step in the realization of meaningful parliamentary, democratic and civilian control over armed forces, for example, many democratic countries and Bosnia and Herzegovina. The themes of Monographs in the modern understanding of process control, is unique in our country and the world in scientific, technical and methodological terms.

Throughout the monograph highlighted three important principles on which the democratic and civilian control of armed forces in general and even armed forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina: (1) Supremacy of civilian over military rule and the effective subordination of the military civilian supreme command. (2) Recognition of the competence of members of the military and the autonomy of the military profession in the professional sphere. (3) Depoliticization of the military and its not mixing in politics.

After analyzing the current state of control over the armed forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina proposed a new mode of organization and implementation of control that includes: democratic and parliamentary control over armed forces, where the responsibility for defense matters delegated to the entities necessary, educating members of the parliamentary commission on control over the armed forces, in addition to the armed forces must control the functioning of the economy and social services, transparency in conducting the process of equipping armed forces, determination of the budget relating to the armed forces of Bosnia and Herzegovina, maintaining constant depoliticization of the armed forces and other issues.
